
Livestock Animals small and large can become dangerous. Cattle can knock down and trample a child without noticing that they are there. A calm animal can become dangerous if it or its offspring feel threatened. Children should have adult supervision when around animals.

Ponds Ponds and other areas of water can be hazardous to young children. If not properly supervised, children can be injured or drown. Children should always have adult supervision in and around water.

Tractors Large farm equipment can be loud and damaging to hearing if proper noise protection is not worn. Children should not be playing behind or around tractors in any circumstance. Tractors are very large and loud, and drivers may not be able to see or hear children in the area. Children should play in a safe area away from any parked or moving equipment.

Farm Chemicals Farm chemicals can be dangerous to children if they are not properly stored. Chemicals should be stored and locked away in a safe location away from children with original containers and labels.

Barbed Wire Fences While good for security and keeping animals at bay it's important to stay away from barbed wire fences so you don't get snagged or cut by the sharp wire barbs.



Grain Wagons and Bins Children should never play around or in any farm equipment. Grain wagons and bins can especially be dangerous as they can lead to grain entrapment.

Farm Yard The farm yard can be very busy with moving vehicles and farm equipment. Children should be careful while playing and avoid areas where vehicles are coming and going.

Farm Machinery Large farm equipment can be loud and damaging to hearing if proper noise protection is not worn. Children should not be playing behind or around tractors in any circumstance. Tractors are very large and loud, and drivers may not be able to see or hear children in the area. Children should play in a safe area away from any parked or moving equipment.

Sun Unprotected exposure to ultra-violet (UV) rays can be dangerous for people of all ages. Children should wear proper protection while playing outside in the sun.
