- First year students may apply during their first semester of school to participate after their second semester
- Graduate students may apply if currently enrolled in school
- Must be eligible to work in Canada

Step 1: Review opportunities of interest to you online.

Step 2: Prepare (or update) your application. Make sure you have an updated resume and that your cover letter is relevant to the position that interests you. Here are some tips to highlight your achievements:

- Your resume should include dates with prior job roles
- Be specific about projects you've worked on or led (e.g., What was the outcome? How was success measured?)
- Highlight any leadership roles in volunteer organizations, clubs, affiliations, internships or part-time jobs; consider including the scope of the work you performed and the size of the team
- Include your GPA, as well as school-related projects or coursework that demonstrate relevant skills and knowledge
- Private information about you is not relevant and can be omitted

Step 3: Complete application. Apply to positions of interest and where your qualifications and skills are a match.
