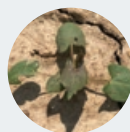

Do I need to use Certitude® herbicide (pre-seed) in order to participate in Advanced Weed Control?

Certitude is not a requirement to participate in Advanced Weed Control unless you are targeting kochia and/or volunteer canola. Certitude (+ glyphosate) followed by Liberty 150 combines Groups 6, 9, 10 and 27 to achieve consistent industry-leading control of kochia and volunteer canola.

Do I need to use Liberty 150 at the 1.62 L/ac rate to qualify for the AWC program?

Liberty 150 needs to be applied at the 1.35 L/ac rate or higher to qualify. The 1.62 L/ac rate is recommended to achieve the most effective control of your most common weeds. The effectiveness of this rate will help you achieve cleaner fields and manage resistance. Ask your BASF **AgSolutions**® Grower Representative before application to match your rate to the label restrictions for your weed spectrum and staging, and to align with your expectations.

Explain to me the Performance Support Guarantee for flushing weed control.

BASF will provide coverage on flushing weed escapes if two applications of Liberty 150 are used in the same canola crop and in the same season (at the 1.35 L/ac rate or higher). Note: The flushing weeds that escaped must be labelled for control at the rate used and weed staging at the time of the original applications. Talk to your BASF **AgSolutions** Grower Representative for further support.

What are the remedial solutions for weed escapes?

If solutions don't work up to labelled expectations, BASF will provide a remedial solution of Liberty 150, Centurion and/or Heat® LQ herbicides. The solution will be based on what will work best for you and what options are available for the specific weed escapes and crop staging when the performance inquiry is finalized.

Proven strategies to tackle your biggest weed challenges.

Kochia: A two-pass approach is the most effective way to manage this challenging weed. Hit kochia early with Certitude plus glyphosate to get ahead of its sizing and clean it up with Liberty 150 in-crop. A combination so powerful, BASF guarantees its performance.

Cleavers: Facet L tank mixed with Liberty 150 controls cleavers up to 6 whorls quickly and effectively to protect the yield and quality of your InVigor® hybrid canola.

Wild oats resistant to Group 1 chemistries: Combining Liberty 150 with Centurion provides a multi-mode of action solution to this increasing weed challenge.

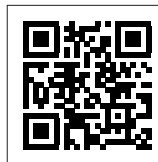
