Growers who haven't grown **Clearfield** lentils before, and plan to in 2022, are required to sign a commitment. This one-time signature allows growers to use the patented trait technology.

It's important for growers to sign a **Clearfield** Commitment, or have their acres registered, to realize these benefits.







How the Clearfield Commitment process works.

To take advantage of BASF Ag Rewards for **Clearfield**, growers must sign a **Clearfield** Commitment form by **July 9, 2022,** following the FOUR steps listed below.











Complete the Commitment together.

As another option for getting growers to complete the **Clearfield** Commitment, seed sellers can use a **Clearfield** lentil Commitment pad. Check the customer list on the Commitment landing page to see if a grower needs to:

- Sign the Clearfield Commitment for lentils
- Update and register seeded acres and varieties that will be grown for the 2022 season

Please ensure all registered seed is **Clearfield**-Confirm tested as the **Clearfield**-Confirm number is necessary to complete the Commitment. You'll need the following information in order to complete the Commitment:

- Seed varieties, number of acres (exact or estimate) or amount of seed in pounds
- Clearfield-Confirm number for each non-pedigreed lentil variety
- Grower's contact information (name, farm name, address, telephone number, province)
- Seed seller's information.
- Signatures from both the grower and a witness

Please make sure you check the box labeled 'Completed with Seller' on the form.

All completed and signed Commitment forms must be received by BASF by email, mail or fax on or before July 9, 2022, in order to take advantage of BASF Ag Rewards for Clearfield.

All farm-saved seed used in the Clearfield Production System for lentils must be Clearfield-Confirm tested. This test ensures the seed sample has not been contaminated with non-Clearfield lentil varieties and that it maintains the appropriate level of tolerance to Clearfield lentil herbicides.

Retailers are not responsible for having Clearfield lentils tested. If the Clearfield-Confirm number is missing, please direct growers to their Clearfield lentil seed seller or to have their seed Clearfield-Confirm tested free of charge at one of these accredited labs.

The Clearfield lentil Seed Quality Offer

For 2022, growers can get a bonus pre-seed quality and disease test package free of charge, just for submitting their lentil seed for **Clearfield**-Confirm testing. Seed samples will also be tested for germination, vigour, diseases and thousand kernel weight (TKW) – all important factors in determining seeding rates and the right seed treatments.

Growers can sign up for this offer by printing a PDF of the sell sheet, Terms and Conditions, and the consent form at **agsolutions.ca/clearfieldlentiloffer**

Grower notes for handling seed samples:

- Place 1 kg of a representative clean seed sample into a resealable bag
- Include a copy of the confirmation email you receive or the consent form
- Send it to or drop it off at any of the participating seed labs listed previously

To qualify for the offer, be sure growers complete <u>all</u> sections, including their consent to privacy.
